

# Parking Lot Rules and Consequences

The following guidelines are in effect for the 2004-2005 school year.

1. **Taking out underclassmen.** Any time a student is caught taking an underclassmen in their car during the school day; or lending/borrowing/sharing another students' car:  
1st Offense - Ten day revoke of driving privileges  
2nd Offense - Sticker revoked for remainder of the year
2. **Careless Driving.** Any student found to be speeding, or disregarding posted traffic signs:  
1st Offense - Warning  
2nd Offense - Ten day revoke of driving privileges  
3rd Offense - Sticker revoked for remainder of the year
3. **Reckless Driving.** Any student who displays a willful disregard of personal property and/or safety:  
1st Offense- Sticker revoked for remainder of the year
4. **Leaving campus without permission.** Any time a student is caught using their car to leave during unauthorized time:  
1st Offense - Ten day revoke of driving privileges  
2nd Offense - Sticker revoked for reminder of year
5. **Vandalism.** Any vandalism, inappropriate behavior, endangering persons and/or property:  
1st Offense - Sticker revoked for remainder of the year
6. **Alcohol, Drugs, and Weapons.** Any student who is found to be under the influence, or in possession of , Alcohol, drugs, or a weapon:  
1st Offense - Sticker revoked for remainder of the year

## Qualifiers:

-Three offenses resulting in suspension may result in the revoking of a parking sticker for the remainder of the year.

## Non-Permit drivers parking on school property without permission:

- 1st Offense - Warning
- 2nd Offense - Saturday Detention
- 3rd Offense - Ineligible for following year parking permit

**No refunds for revoked parking stickers.** Partial refunds will be given to transfers and early graduates.

**Transfer of parking stickers is prohibited. Any transfer will mean immediate revoke of that sticker.**

\*\*\*\*Any student with a parking sticker who must drive a non-stickered vehicle must park in the designated Temporary Parking Area, located on the west side of the lot by the tennis courts. The student will need to report the vehicle information to Mrs. Blum before 9 a.m. on that day. Failure to do so will follow the procedure for Non-permit drivers listed above.

\*\*\*\*Any student vehicle is subject to search at any time.
