ATI TEAS Pre-Admission Test

Saint Anthony College of Nursing utilizes the proctored, online ATI TEAS assessment test (Test of Essential Academic Skills) as part of the admission process.

Once a student submits their SACN application and application fee, they will receive a list of the available TEAS testing dates to choose from. The TEAS test must be taken by/before the application deadline date in order for the student's application process to be complete.

TEAS Test Protecols Test Day


- Arrive 10 15 minutes prior to your test time.
- Must present valid photo ID.
- Cell phones and other electronics are not permitted for use during testing.
- No children are permitted in the test area.
- Students may take short breaks between the four components of the test.
- Acts of dishonesty are subject to disciplinary action.

ABOUT....

The maximum amount of time allotted for the ATI TEAS is 209 minutes (about 3.5 hours). Each section is timed: Reading - 64 minutes; Math - 54 minutes: Science - 63 minutes; English - 28 minutes.

- Reading (53 questions): Paragraph comprehension, passage comprehension and informational source comprehension.
- Math (36 questions): Numbers and operations, algebraic applications, data interpretation and measurement.
- Science (53 questions): Human body science; life science, earth and physical science and scientific reasoning.
- English and Language Usage (28 questions): Grammar and word meanings in context, sentence structure, punctuation and spelling.

RESULTS....

- After the assessment is complete, you may log into the <u>ATI website</u> and choose the My Results tab to view your test scores. We are looking for a score of 58.7 or higher with a category of Proficient or higher.
- Look for the Adjusted Individual Total Score (AITS). This is your composite score. Your adjusted individual scores for each section may be found below the AITS. Your scores are valid for 3 years.
- You can retake the ATI TEAS for \$65. There isn't a limit to how many retests you can take.
- If you have taken the ATI TEAS at a location other than Saint Anthony College of Nursing, you may submit a hard copy of the results page to the Admissions Department, or submit an official TEAS transcript from the ATI website to the college at Admissions@sacn.edu.
