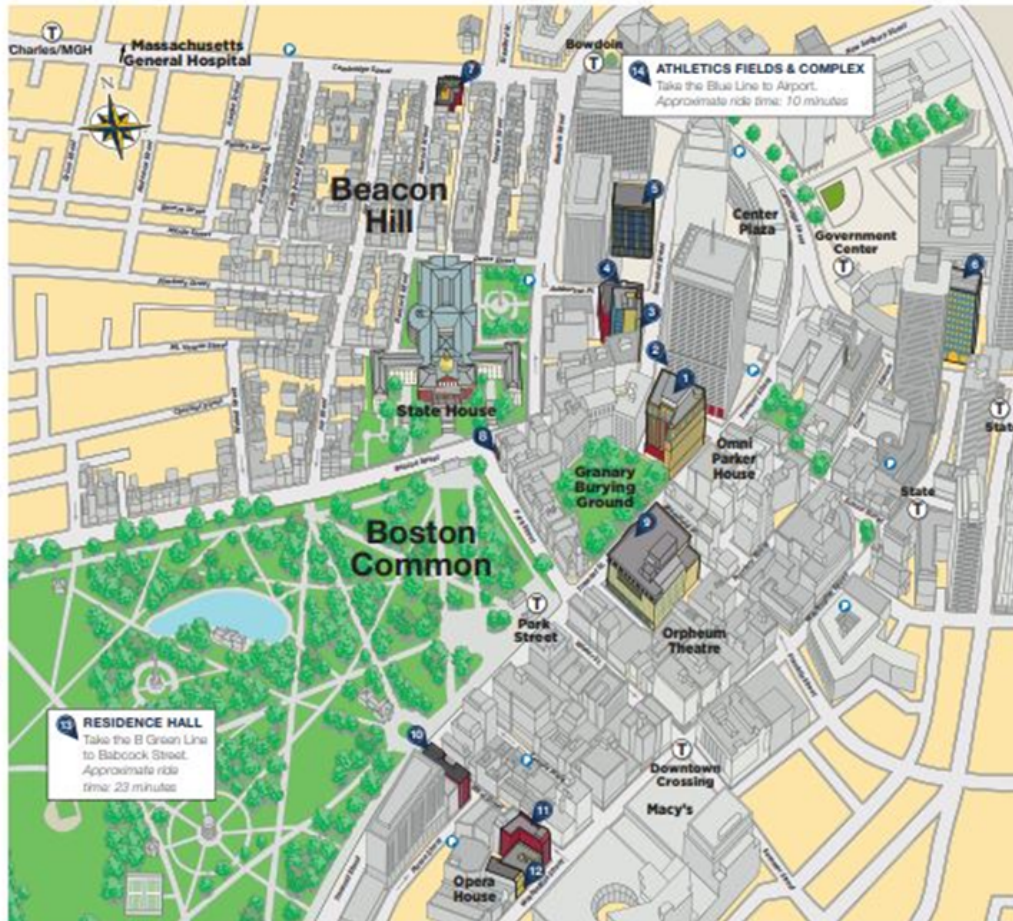

# Application Tips and Financial Aid

- Application Requirements

- Common application or Suffolk Application
- High School Transcript
- Essay
- One letter of Recommendation
- OPTIONAL: SAT or ACT score

- Application Deadlines

- Early Action: November 15<sup>th</sup>
- Regular Decision: February 15<sup>th</sup>

- Financial Aid

- ALL students are automatically considered for merit aid scholarships
- FAFSA form is required for need based consideration
