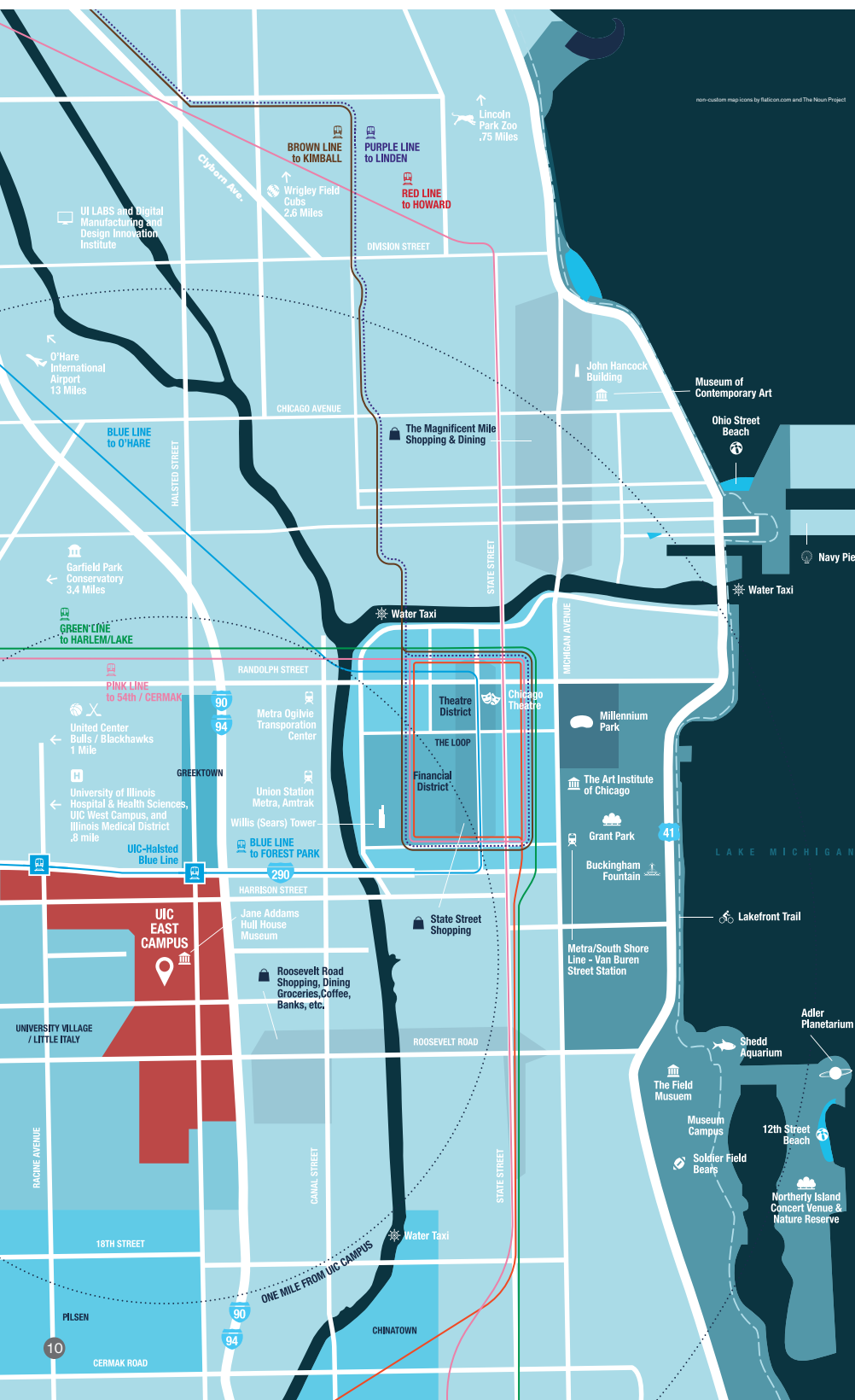

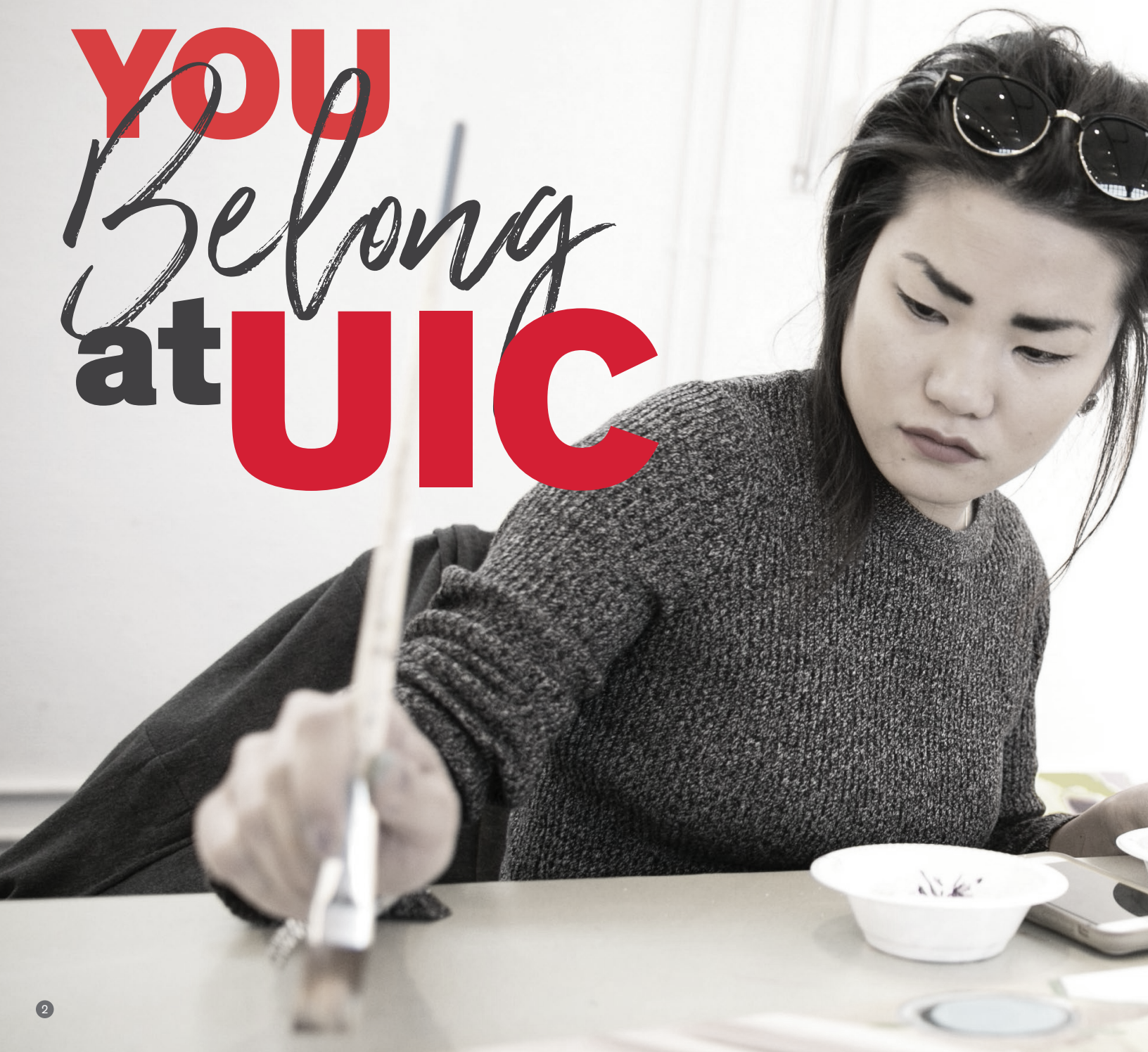

Pathways to UIC

Each pathway to admission has its own advantage. Be mindful of requirements and dates when choosing the one that's right for you.

PLANNING PAYS OFF.

EARLY ACTION — APPLY BY NOVEMBER 1

Early Action is a nonbinding application process. EA applicants get a faster decision and priority consideration for scholarships — no strings attached. Deferred applicants have time to bulk up their application for the next round.

REGULAR DECISION — APPLY BY FEBRUARY 1

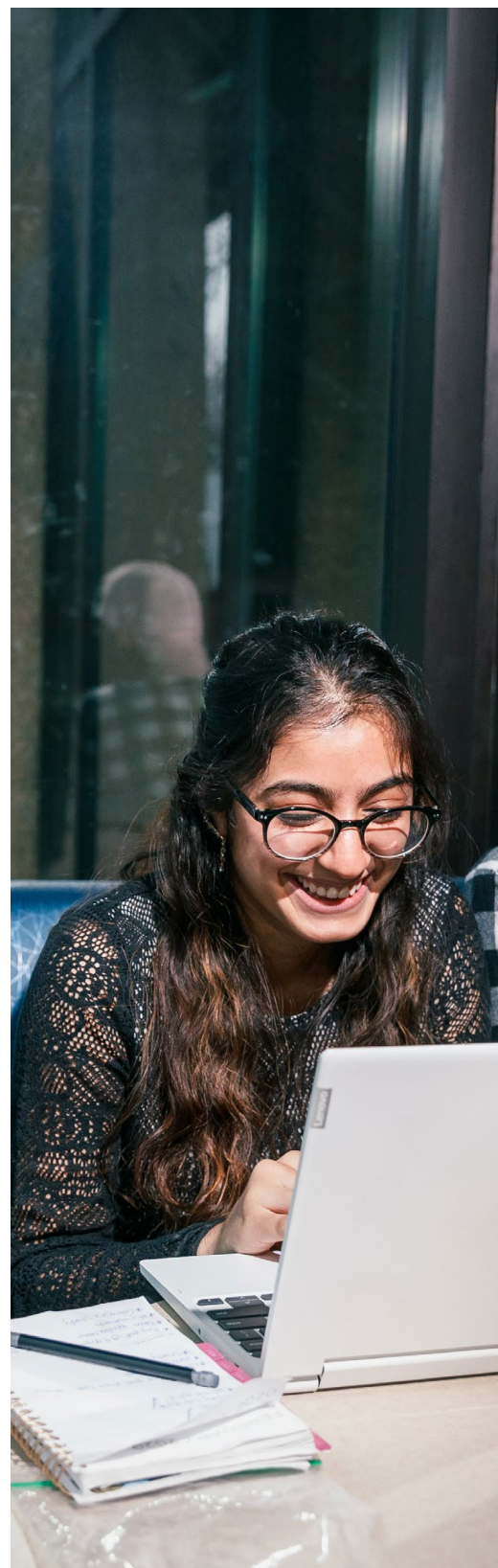
This is the most common application process offered at colleges and universities. Candidates receive an admission decision between December and March.

These figures represent estimated costs for students attending full time and living on campus.

- 1. MANDATORY** — Listed tuition is the base rate. Some programs may have additional costs.
- 2. OPTIONAL** — The health insurance fee can be waived if evidence of equivalent coverage is provided. Room and board is optional at UIC, the estimate above includes the cost of a traditional-style room on campus.
- 3. ESTIMATE** — These values are the estimates used to package financial aid. They are not billed by the university. Actual costs may vary depending on living arrangements and other factors.

Financing YOUR EDUCATION

UIC makes college accessible with loans, customized payment plan options, student employment opportunities, and scholarships. Our tuition rate is also locked in for four years.

FINANCIAL AID

UIC's FAFSA code: 001776

Apply for financial aid between October 1 and the February 1 priority date to maximize your eligibility for need-based aid.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Different departments, programs, and colleges offer scholarships. Most UIC scholarship programs review the information provided in your application.

JUST HOW MUCH IS A UIC DEGREE WORTH? A LOT.

Over 20 years, \$419,000 more than the average grad. PayScale ranks UIC in the top 15 percent of universities nationwide for return on investment. The Wall Street Journal and Times Higher Education also list UIC among the top two dozen public universities in the U.S. The ranking considered student outcomes like alumni earnings, reputation, and ability to repay student debt.
